

## **Guidelines for the “Dave Campbell – Friends of Evans Lake Rock”**

### **I) CATEGORIES FOR INCLUSION**

1. Clubs and Associations - i.e. Hoo-Hoo Club #48, Lions, Rotary, Elks, Kiwanis, etc.
2. User Groups i.e. schools, church groups, youth groups, Scouts, Cubs, Guides, community groups and other organizations fraternal or otherwise, who have used the camp
3. Junior Forest Wardens (B.C.) i.e. Leaders, clubs, organization administrators
4. Evans Lake Staff i.e. summer/winter camps, volunteers, other camp/office staff
5. Miscellaneous i.e. Groups not represented in the above categories but who have contributed to the enhancement of the Evans Lake experience  
i.e. financial contributors, contractors, professional groups, long time serving Board Members, B.C. Truck Loggers Assoc.

### **II) CRITERIA GUIDELINES**

#### **1. Individuals**

One or more of the following criteria for individuals who were or continue to be involved with Evans Lake Forest Education Society could apply.

- a. Who have worked for or at camp either in a paid or volunteer position and who have provided outstanding, long-time service to the Evans Lake camp or to the Society - minimum of 10 years. This could include present sitting Board of Directors members and current staff.
- b. Who have significantly contributed financial or other support - such as ongoing support for camperships, new major equipment, etc.
- c. Who have contributed significantly to the camp’s culture, history, programs, or physical development - such as renovations, new structures, docks, trails, etc.
- d. Who as school teachers and/ or program leaders have continued to use Evans Lake as their camp of choice for their school’s Outdoor Ed. Programs - minimum of 10 years.

#### **2. Organizations, Schools, etc.**

- a. Schools that over an extended period of years that have continued to return to the camp and have contributed to the enhancement of the Evans Lake experience minimum of 10 years.
- b. Organizations that over an extended period of time have contributed financially, or other support to enhance the camp’s culture, history, or development - i.e. Hoo-Hoo Club #48.

### **III. NOMINATION PROCESS**

1. The Nomination period would run from July 1 - April 1.
2. The Committee will accept nominations up to a maximum of four candidates for any given year
3. The Nomination form will be available to the membership on the website by July1 for that year. **Only current members in good standing** can nominate a candidate.
4. Nomination forms to be returned to the Committee by **April 1** ( e-mail, fax, or post)
5. The Committee will review the Nominees by **April 30** and present their choices to the Board of Directors for their consideration.
6. The inauguration of the new members onto the Dave Campbell “Friends of Evans Lake” Rock would occur annually at the Open House at Evans Lake.

Bill Forsyth	One of the originators of the Dave Campbell “Friends of Evans Lake” award. Former Junior Forest Warden, summer camp counsellor, custodian, and camp Program Director.
Dave Cullen	Chief Warden of Canada (Junior Forest Wardens), former JFW club leader, worked on camp development in the 70s and 80’s. Presently a retired Firefighter.
Conor Lorimer	Current Director of Operations & Education – ELFES. Was a camper and staff member since 1999. Presently Secretary for B.C. Camping Association.
Lauren Marghetti	Current Executive Director – ELFES. Was a camper, counsellor, and senior staff member for summer camp. Presently Member-at-Large for B.C. Camping Association.
Gary Haensgen	Former summer Camp Director, instructor, and Vancouver secondary P.E. teacher. Present Board member and chair of the Nomination committee. Inducted onto the Rock in 2004.
